



ABOUT SAGAR



Sagar (Saugor), is a city in Madhya Pradesh, is a nature's beauty situated on a spur of the vindhya range and 1758 ft. above sea-level, and around 180km northeast of state capital Bhopal. Its original name "Saugor" is an amalgamation of two words namely "SAU" meaning 100 and "GARH" Meaning Fort as there were countless small-forts in this region. With time name has changed from "Saugor" to "Sagar". It is the 6th largest city in the province of Madhya Pradesh. Sagar also happens to be the exact centre of original undivided India. The granite bench mark by British Surveyors indicating this, is placed in the compound of a Church in Sagar Cantonment, next to a branch of the Oriental Bank of Commerce.

Sagar is a handsomely built University town with great beauty and cultural heritage. Hindi is the official language of the city. While Bundelkhandi is the local dialect. Sagar is well know for its contribution to Hindi literature and hosts a number of writers, poets and other leading artists in their respective fields. The region is popular on India's Tourism scene, due to its cultural heritage and diversity. Some places of interest in and around Sagar are the Rahatgarh Water fall, Garhpahra Mountains and Temples, Khimlasa Forts and Nauradehi Wild sanctuary. Sagar has an army cantonment unit. The city, know as the heart of Madhya Pradesh. Sagar hold a large part of the city to the Army with Military Battalion like MRC etc. being its part. Central University of Sagar, established in 1946 through the efforts of Dr. Hari Singh Gour, was the first University to be established in Madhya Pradesh and it's the 18th University established in India. Situated on top of hills overlooking the town it has an extensively large University Teaching Department (UTD) Campus.

HOW TO REACH SAGAR (SAUGOR)

A very prominent city of Bundelkhand Region, Sagar (Saugor) is well connected by rail network. It is situated about 600 km from DELHI and 200 km from Katni, Jablapur and Jhansi (U.P.) Bhopal the capital of Madhya Pradesh, is about 208 km from Sagar by road and rail. Sagar is situated between Bina-Katni Junction, 75 km from Bina and 188 km Katni Junction. Bhopal, Jabalpur, Indore (450 km) and Khajuraho (200 km) are well connected by flights.
